- 3/21/1 Apologies for absence: RESOLVED** that the following absences be noted:  
a) County Councillor David Whipp (no apologies received).
- 3/21/2 Declarations of Interest: RESOLVED** that Councillor Fitton declared an interest in item 12 (a) of the agenda (minute number
- 3/21/3 Minutes: RESOLVED** that the minutes of the Ordinary Parish Council Meeting held on January 11<sup>th</sup> 2021 were confirmed as a true record and were signed by the Chair.
- 3/21/4 Public Participation: RESOLVED** that a representative of the Village Hall presented a proposal for the installation of electric vehicle charge points. The Hall has been approached by a not-for-profit company who are interested in installing these. The Parish Council will be kept informed as this is further investigated.
- 3/21/5 Progress Reports: RESOLVED** that Councillor Robson provided an update to the Parish Council. A new policy and a table of green spaces had been added to the plan. After a final proof read, it would be submitted to Eden District Council.
- 3/21/6 Accounts:**  
a) **RESOLVED** that the Council agreed to make payments as detailed in the payment schedule.  
b) **RESOLVED** that Councillors received the bank reconciliation.
- 3/21/7 Highways and Maintenance: RESOLVED** that the following issues were discussed;  
a) **RESOLVED** that Councillor Hancock would purchase a light for outside Morland House.  
b) **RESOLVED** that issues at the bottom of Lowergate are ongoing and that Councillor Wilson was awaiting a response from Cumbria Highways.  
c) **RESOLVED** that an engineer had inspected Force Bridge and Town End Bridge, and that work would be scheduled by Cumbria County Council.  
d) **RESOLVED** that concerns were raised regarding recent diversion routes employed during roadworks, demonstrating a lack of local knowledge.  
**ACTION** Clerk to contact Cumbria Highways to request local input is taken on board.  
e) **RESOLVED** that ongoing concerns regarding water running down Little Appleby Road were discussed.  
**ACTION** Clerk to contact Cumbria Highways.
- 3/21/8 Grass cutting: RESOLVED** that the Council agreed to contract Mark Binney to cut the grass in the Parish in 2021.
- 3/21/9 Allotments: RESOVLED** that more interest had been expressed in the allotments. Issues with sitting water on the site following heavy rain were acknowledged. Councillors Wilson and Fitton has featured in a positive article in the Cumberland and Westmorland Herald regarding the development of the allotment.
