1/23/1 Apologies for absence: RESOLVED that there were no apologies to give.

1/23/2 Declarations of Interest: RESOLVED that no declarations of interest were made.

1/23/3 Minutes: RESOLVED that the minutes of the Ordinary Parish Council Meeting held on Thursday 14th November 2022 were agreed as a true record and signed by the Chair.

1/23/4 Public Participation: RESOLVED that the following issues were raised;

a) Concerns were raised regarding litter being left after recycling collection.

ACTION: Clerk to contact Eden District Council.

b) A poplar tree has come down at the beck, beyond allotments.

ACTION: Clerk to contact Environment Agency.

- c) District Councillor Tonkin informed the meeting that Flusco recycling centre would not be receiving furniture at present, expected to continue until the end of January.
- d) At Church lane, water run-off is creating ice patches.

ACTION: Clerk to report.

- e) At Halmshaw's garage, overhanging tress are making difficulties for bus pickups.
- f) Issues with water run off outside The Stables and at Hill Flat, eroding the wall and road surface.

ACTION: Councillor Wilson to speak to Highways.

Allotments: RESOLVED that the Council and residents in attendance were informed that the allotment field had passed to a new owner through inheritance, and a sale was being considered. The Parish Council are in the process of applying for grant funding to help cover the cost of a potential purchase. This would help secure the long-term future of the site. Councillor Wilson thanked the allotment holders for their efforts in improving and maintaining the site.

1/23/6 Neighbourhood Development Plan: RESOLVED that the meeting was informed that the plan was in its final stages, and would be submitted to Eden District Council.

1/23/7 Highways and Maintenance: RESOLVED that the following issues were discussed;

- a) Pothole on road outside Morland Hall.
- b) Deterioration of road sides out towards Ivy Cottage.
- c) Deterioration of road on the road to Kings Meaburn,
- d) Leaves at Wilson Brow.
- e) Issues at Cliburn bridge, with the meander in river approaching the road. Discussions are ongoing between the landowner and the Environment Agency.
- f) Grass cutting tender to remain the same for next year.

1/23/8 Play Area: RESOLVED that Councillor Wilson was waiting for a quote for fencing and for the repair od the toddler unit. This has now been fenced off. Sovereign were still to provide a date for repair of their play equipment. A drainage issues at the site was being looked at by a neighbouring property.
